- In **U.S. Bank's SEL-2021-055** published on October 8, 2021, we reminded lenders that FHA indicated that they will not be extending the temporary requirements and flexibilities that were effective for Application Received Dates through June 30, 2021 to Mortgages with Application Received Dates through September 30, 2021 for the following:
 - SEL-2020-022 Temporary Flexibilities for Verification of Business for FHA
 - SEL-2020-069 FHA Temporary Guidance Self-Employment and Rental Income

As a follow up to that original communication, the additional documentation and reserves requirements were applied to FHA, VA, and RD COVID-19 policies. With this update, they are being removed and are no longer required.

U.S. Bank will follow requirements listed in the 4000.1, VA Lenders Handbook, and RD 3555.1.

FHA has announced the Single-Family Housing Policy Handbook 4000.1 updates.

Updates and Clarifications

FHA has incorporated previously published Mortgagee Letters into the 4000.1. Clarifications, additions and deletions have also been made. A redline version can be found 4000.1 Updates.

One key change is that if the borrower does not hold the deposit account solely, the lender is no longer required to obtain a letter from non-borrowing parties that the borrower has full access and use of the funds.
